

NO. 496 SURREY- A Light One Horse Surrey

 $\begin{array}{ll} \textbf{Body} {\longleftarrow} \textbf{Full bracket front, heavy steel rocker plates.} & \textbf{Bailey body loops.} \end{array}$

Seats—Strongly ironed; good style.

Top-Canopy. Fringe and lining to match trimming of seats.

Trimming—14 oz. broadcloth or whipcord; spring cushions and backs, full length velvet carpet, full length fenders and curved dash, oil burning lamps.

Gear—Axles 1_{16}^{1} inch long distance pattern, faintailed and swedged; axle beds hand fitted and glued to axles. Springs $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch, four and five plate, oil tempered and graded. Full circle fifth wheel, rear king bolt, reaches ironed full length. Track 4 feet 8 inches.

Wheels—Locke & Jewell, Sarven patent or band hub, 1/8 or 1 inch round edge steel tire. Screwed rims.

Painting—Body and seats black; gear and wheels Brewster green or carmine.
